During Easter week I had the privilege of visiting the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe for the second time in my life and climbing Tepeyac Hill — the namesake of Tepeyac OB/GYN — for the first time. When I visited almost 35 years ago, I was performing abortions in my training, and there I found myself, face-to-face staring at *the* image of Our Lady of Guadalupe —patroness of the unborn. I was not open, back then, to God's will for my life and dismissed a voice I heard

clear and strong ask *me "Why are you hurting me?"* I pondered the question only briefly then. Why are you hurting me? What does that even mean? I'm going to be a doctor. I don't hurt people. I heal people!



I regret dismissing the divine voice that spoke to my heart that day, and I am grateful Our Lady did not give up on me. I eventually had a conversion of heart, the seeds of which were planted that summer day in 1987 in Mexico City. I later went on to create our life-affirming OB/GYN practice in 1994 and named it Tepeyac so that I would never forget the moment Our Lady first called me to conversion.

I am so grateful to have had this second chance to visit as a man transformed by the mercy of a loving Father. With Carolyn at my side, I finally climbed Tepeyac Hill! In my ignorance I had no interest in it back in '87. The photo above shows Tepeyac Hill rising behind us. Tears, prayers, burros, and blessings filled the time!

My pilgrimage reminded me that we must not domesticate the message of the Resurrection. Let it unnerve us and unsettle us, change us, and set us on fire to help the Spirit renew the face of medicine. The crucified and risen Lord and the Woman of Genesis and Revelation with her Son there and now on the Tilma brings us all into the saving mystery of Divine Mercy.

Today, if you hear his voice, harden not your hearts (Hebrews 3:15). Thank you for your continued support for life-affirming medicine.




