Dear Friends:

I received a moving gift this week from Hannah, Elizabeth, Peter and Madeline Hoeppner (pictured above). These beautiful children donated \$200 — the proceeds of their summer lemonade stand — to Divine Mercy Care.

Their gift has me thinking a lot about almsgiving, the role it plays in our work at DMC and Tepeyac OB/GYN, and how distinct it is from fundraising. In my conversion to pro-life medicine, the Blessed Mother told me I needed to see the poor every day. We've always

struggled financially as a practice, swimming against the tide of medicine, and trying to make ends meet practicing life-affirming medicine, including keeping an open door to women in need. DMC was created to fundraise for Tepeyac OB/GYN but over the years I've come to appreciate how much more than fundraising is the act of humbling ourselves to beg for assistance and running a medical practice that depends so much on the sacrificial giving of our community.

What I have come to appreciate is how central almsgiving is to bringing the heart of Christ into medicine. It truly transforms caring for patients into caring about patients. Almsgiving is good for doctors as it helps us divest our trust from money onto God's providence. Almsgiving is good for the poor because they are included in excellent medicine alongside the privileged class who have insurance. Almsgiving is also good for the giver. The "Doctor" of the Gospels, Luke, talks about the cleansing power of almsgiving (Luke 11:41), connecting almsgiving with storing treasure in Heaven. Jesus doesn't appeal to self interest, but almsgiving is an act of great faith and great mercy, tapping into the font of Divine Mercy that governs God's heart for His people on earth. Almsgiving leads to unimagined compensation for you, for us, and for our patients and your sisters and brothers in the human family, letting them know "they are one of us."

So thank you, Hoeppner family, for your beautiful, loving sacrificial gift! Thank you also to the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council, Phil Bettwy and the Knights of Columbus Council 12846 in Springfield, Virginia (pictured below) for your ultrasound initiative and generous support of Tepeyac OB/GYN. Thank you all for the countless gifts, big and small, that you have given to Divine Mercy Care. Your almsgiving is a pillar of what medicine should be, and you play a deep and personal role in the provision of life-affirming medicine at Tepeyac each and every day.
